

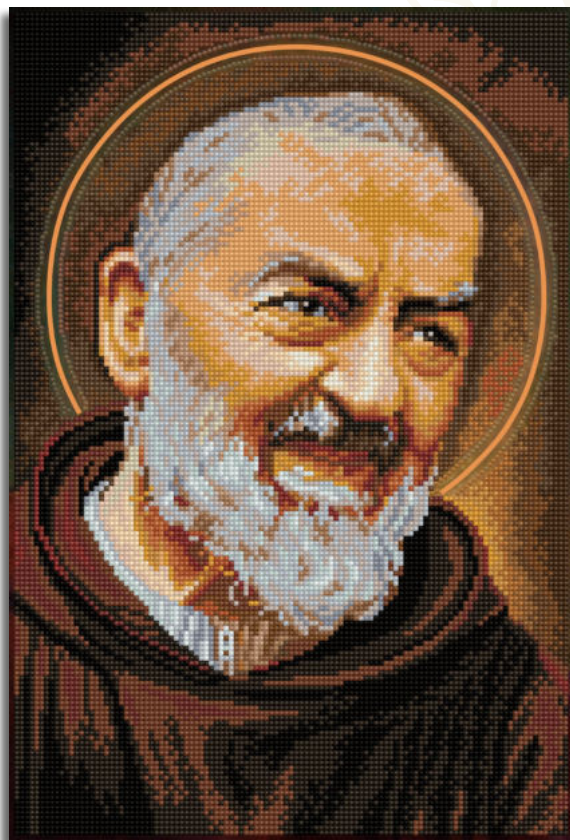

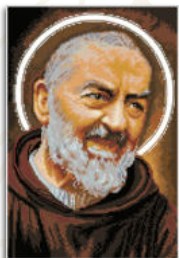

Also known as Saint Pio of Pietrelcina was an Italian friar, priest, and mystic, who is venerated as a saint in the Catholic Church.



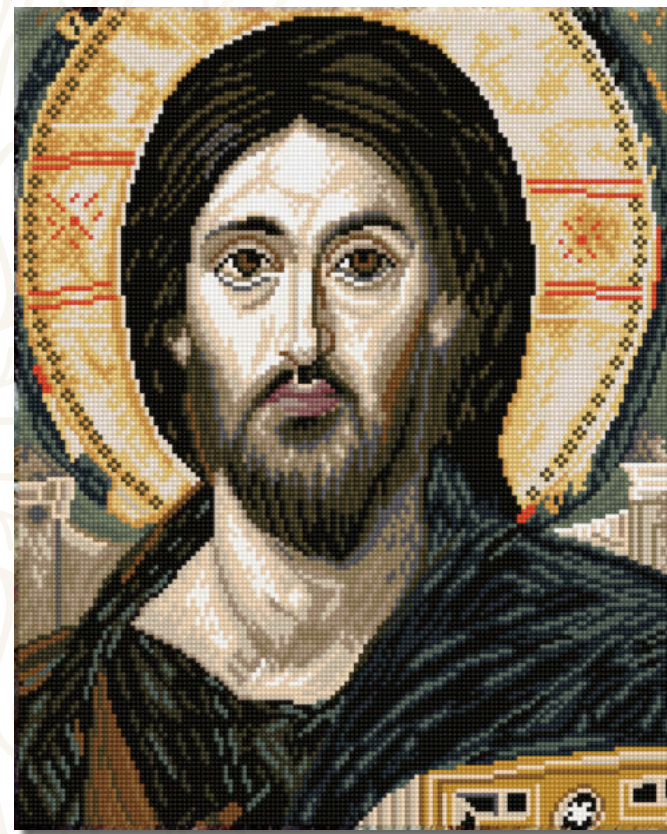

"This interpretation is after the famous painting by Roberto Ferruzzi, created in 1897. It is most popularly known as "La Madonnina" or "Madonna of the streets""

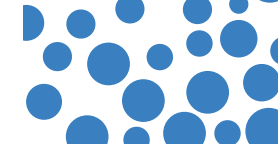

This interpretation is after the famous painting by Giovanni Battista Salvi da Sassoferrato (circa 1650) and is known as "The Virgin in Prayer"



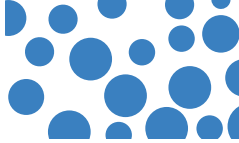
